Why the Changes? Vision 2020



Transportation Focus:

Increase the efficiency of bus routes

- Develop practices and guidelines of service levels
- Implement guidelines based on best practices for routing

Process - Transportation Committee



- Reviewed best practices (stops, ride times, walking distances)
- Conducted Surveys
- Reviewed funding options
- Created Guidelines
- Implemented changes in 2016-2017



Transportation Guidelines

- Walking distances by school/grade:
 - K = House or corner stop, 0.15 miles
 - 1-2 = Corner stop, 0.15 miles
 - Half Day = Corner stop, 0.20 miles
 - Daniel Wright = Community stop, 0.30 miles
- Ride Times
 - Between 30-45 minutes
- Each stop adds approximately 30 seconds to the route, 1 min in winter

Fiscal Sustainability



Budget

- \$1.8 million for 2017-2018 for transportation
- Each bus = \$50,000 to the budget
- Competing dollars for:
 - Increasing enrollment
 - Maintaining appropriate class sizes
 - Implementing teaming at Daniel Wright
 - Increasing space capacity at all three schools
 - Maintain a balanced budget

Bussing Issues Being Reported



- Late Buses
- Long rides
- Crowded seats
- No more house stops
- Safety at corners
- No sidewalks
- Others
